What are the main liability concerns for parties involved in digital transactions, and how does legislation address them?</p> <p>Question 3: Define cybercrime and explain the role of cybersecurity in mitigating such threats. Discuss the legal challenges involved in prosecuting cross-border cybercrimes within the European Union.</p> <p>Question 4: Explain the main forms of intellectual property protection applicable to digital content. Discuss the challenges posed by digital technologies to the enforcement of IP rights and how legal frameworks are adapting to address these issues.</p>
